

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
03-18-2024

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, March 18th, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Rick Coleman, Larry Bishop, and City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, City Clerk Nicholas New, Police Chief Richard Bickerstaff, Court Clerk Jodie McKinney, and Breanna Minter from the Clay Times Journal.

Mayor Roy Adamson called the meeting to order. Mayor then asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member Proctor and seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was made by Council Member Appleby and seconded by Council Member Coleman to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was to approve the demolition of the downtown building on Hwy 9. We have spoken to the owner multiple times and no work has been done and now the roof has fell in. A motion was made by Councilmember Proctor and seconded by Councilmember Smith to move forward with the demolition. The vote was unanimous.

Next on the agenda was to hire structural engineer Jeremy Deal from Barrett Jones & Wilson to conduct site work on the demolition of the Hwy 9 building. We have used him in the past for other building demolitions and had no issues. A motion was made by Councilmember Appleby and seconded by Councilmember Coleman to approve this hire. The vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Proctor mentioned that the streets are looking great, that the new street sweeper is doing a good job.

City Supervisor Taylor gave an update on Jeffery Harris. Jeffery has worked 3 days a week the past two weeks, but will be back in the hospital today to take chemo treatments until Thursday.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Bishop and seconded by Council Member Coleman. The vote was unanimous. The Meeting ended at 5:07 p.m.
